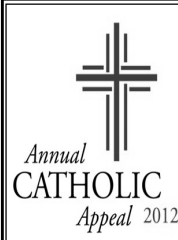
## CONGRATULATIONS

**To Frank Ahern on his election to the Seattle University Athletic Hall of Fame.** Frank is to be inducted in the Special Recognition category, established for Seattle U graduates who made a significant impact on athletics outside the University's athletics department. Ahern's coaching career spanned seven decades with stops at Seattle Prep, Franklin, Cleveland, Asa Mercer Junior High, Seattle Community College, O'Dea, Highline Community College, and Garfield. One of Ahern's many pupils was Seattle U Athletic Hall of Famer Jim Harney, the captain of the 1958 Seattle U men's basketball team that reached the NCAA title game.
